**Recent Parish History - Two years ago this week, this appeal appeared in the Bulletin**

**“PARISH NECESSITIES**

As one of the parish administrators appointed by Cardinal Dolan last year, I had the very great advantage of friendship with my immediate predecessor, your Pastor Emeritus, Fr. Robert Quarato. Therefore, he let me know well in advance about the many challenges to our parish finances which would need to be met sooner rather than later in order to maintain the physical plant of our beloved Holy Rosary. Since arriving last July 1st, Fr. Quarato's list has grown to include the following:

- 1) Repair to the roof of the church and re-pointing of brickwork on the east side of the church. There is a leak evident in the Msgr. Sheridan room off Father Winters Hall.
- 2) Repair of many serious cracks in our parking lot and its subsequent sealing.
- 3) Repair of the staircases leading from the parking lot and Eastchester Road to the main entrance of Holy Rosary Church.
- 4) The purchase of a new organ for Holy Rosary (the current instrument is over 20 years old and in danger of collapse).
- 5) The purchase and installation of a new public address/sound system in the church (the current system is obsolete, breaks down frequently, and has reached its limit of capacity to be repaired, as the necessary parts are no longer manufactured).
- 6) The electrical rewiring of the rectory (the current wiring is still basically that which was installed when the rectory was constructed in 1925).
- 7) Repair and painting of the parking lot fence on Mickel Avenue.

With the exception of the purchase of a new organ for the church, and the repair of the church steps, the price for each of these projects is relatively modest. While we do not already have bids on all of these projects, the new sound system and the roof repairs each cost approximately \$5000.00. While you might not have noticed, recent extensive repairs have been made to our outside lighting system and more are yet to come. The outdoor statues' lights have to be repaired, as well as our church's heating and cooling system. We have a new water purification system in our church boiler room, and there have been expenses incurred (not covered by insurance) from last summer's unfortunate car accident which severely damaged the Adee Avenue fence and electric gate. Our wonderful Holy Name Society has been greatly helpful in maintaining the day-to-day upkeep of our plant, but since these projects require outside vendors, I must humbly request that you consider making a contribution to these many necessary repairs and/or purchases. With your help, our parish will thrive for at least another 90 years. Please consider contributing towards these projects. More details about our fund raising will be given in future bulletins. God love you, Fr Dennis Williams"

I am happy and grateful to report that thanks to the wonderful generosity of Holy Rosary parishioners, all of this has been accomplished (except that the church roof has developed a new leak and the rectory rewiring has not been done). God bless you, Fr. Williams
